ERRATA ORDER

(Issued June 21, 1999)

On May 28, 1999, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an "Order Approving Settlement" in this proceeding. In Ordering Clause Two of that order, the Board stated, "MidAmerican shall continue to file comparison filings based on the schedule set in the May 19, 1995, "Final Decision and Order," in Docket No. RPU-94-3". However, in referencing the schedule set in the May 19, 1995, "Final Decision and Order," the Board inadvertently overlooked the fact that the Board had slightly modified the filing schedule on rehearing. In the June 30, 1995, "Order Granting Rehearing in Part and Denying Rehearing in Part," the Board stated, "The Board will grant rehearing and modify the order to allow Midwest Gas¹ four months to file comparison information after the six-month comparison period."

Therefore, Ordering Clause Two of the Board's May 28, 1999, "Order Approving Settlement" will be modified to reference the filing schedule set in the

May 19, 1995, "Final Decision and Order," as modified by the June 30, 1995, "Order Granting Rehearing in Part and Denying Rehearing in Part."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Ordering Clause Two in the May 28, 1999, "Order Approving Settlement" in this docket is modified to read, as follows:

2. The Board will continue to conduct a review on a semi-annual basis in which actual costs will be compared to the reference costs. MidAmerican shall continue to file comparison filings based on the schedule set in the May 19, 1995, "Final Decision and Order," as modified by the June 30, 1995, "Order Granting Rehearing in Part and Denying Rehearing in Part."
