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**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

(Issued April 21, 2000)

On March 24, 2000, MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed tariff, identified as TF-00-74, in compliance with the Board's order issued March 14, 2000, in Docket No. TF-99-94. The Board's March 14 order approved, with modification, a settlement involving a buy-through tariff that would allow electric interruptible customers to negotiate with MidAmerican for the purchase of power to avoid interruption. As originally proposed the buy-through option only applied to MidAmerican's eastern pricing zone. The Board's March 14 order required MidAmerican to extend the buy-through option to all its pricing zones.

The Board will approve the proposed tariff. The tariff extends the buy-through option to all of MidAmerican's pricing zones. Other terms and limitations of the tariff are in compliance with the settlement and the Board's March 14, 2000, order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

Docket No. TF-00-74 is approved, effective May 1, 2000, subject to complaint or investigation.
