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ORDER REGARDING REPORT

(Issued May 1, 2000)

On May 19, 1995, the Utilities Board (Board) issued its "Final Decision and Order" in this proceeding, and on June 30, 1995, the Board issued an "Order Granting Rehearing in Part and Denying Rehearing in Part." In those orders, the Board approved MidAmerican Energy Company's (MidAmerican) Incentive Gas Supply Procurement Plan (IGSPP) for a three-year period. The Board directed MidAmerican to file reports of the results of the plan on a semiannual basis. The initial three-year plan period was completed on October 31, 1998.

On April 27, 1999, MidAmerican and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice filed a proposed settlement allowing the plan to continue through October 2000. The Board approved the settlement on May 28, 1999. The Board approved an amendment to the settlement on February 17, 2000.

On March 31, 2000, MidAmerican filed the results of the second period of the two-year IGSPP extension. The report covers gas procurement costs from May 1999 through October 1999. MidAmerican divided gas procurement costs into four categories: reservation costs, supply costs, storage costs, and transportation costs.

The Board has reviewed MidAmerican's second report of the two-year IGSP extension. MidAmerican will be required to reflect the reward calculation in its May 2000 through October 2000 purchased gas adjustments.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

MidAmerican Energy Company shall file purchased gas adjustments for the period from May 2000 through October 2000 that reflect the calculations contained in its March 31, 2000, IGSP report.
