**ORDER DOCKETING AMENDMENT TO NEGOTIATED  
INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT FOR COMMENTS**

(Issued June 14, 2000)

On January 26, 2000, U S WEST Communications, Inc. (U S WEST), and Integra Telecom of Iowa, Inc. (Integra), filed a negotiated interconnection agreement for review by the Utilities Board (Board) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). The proceeding was docketed as NIA-00-8. The Board issued an order on March 21, 2000, approving the negotiated interconnection agreement. On June 2, 2000, U S WEST and Integra filed an amendment to the interconnection agreement to add the terms, conditions, and rates for dark fiber.

The parties to the negotiation or any other interested party may submit written comments supporting approval or rejection of the agreement within 30 days of the filing under 199 IAC 38.7(4). Accordingly, the Board will accept written comments on or before July 3, 2000. The Board will determine what procedures are appropriate for review of the agreement after any comments are filed. Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(4), the Board must approve or reject the interconnection

agreement within 90 days of the submission of the agreement or the agreement will be deemed approved.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

Comments supporting approval or rejection of the amendment to the negotiated interconnection agreement, by the parties to the negotiation or other interested parties, shall be filed on or before July 3, 2000.
