**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND ISSUING CERTIFICATE**

(Issued August 2, 2000)

On April 15, 1999, Spencer Municipal Communications Utility (Spencer) filed an application for issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity, pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29 (1999), stating its intention to provide local exchange service to the Spencer exchange currently served by Qwest Corporation, f/k/a U S WEST Communications, Inc. The Utilities Board (Board) issued an "Order Granting Application and Approving Map," on June 22, 1999.

Spencer submitted its proposed tariff on May 17, 2000, and gave notice to all affected local exchange carriers. Spencer filed a statement of dialing parity indicating that it will offer inter- and intraLATA dialing parity.

The Board has reviewed the proposed tariff, as revised, and finds it substantially complies with the Board rules for local exchange service tariffs. The Board will approve the tariff effective the date of this order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The tariff filed by Spencer Municipal Communications Utility on May 17, 2000, identified as TF-00-119, is approved, effective on the date of issuance of this order.

2. A certificate, identified as Certificate No. 0218, is issued to Spencer Municipal Communications Utility concurrent with this order.
