AMENDED CERTIFICATE

(Issued August 30, 2000)

On June 6, 2000, Jordan-Soldier Valley Telephone Company, Inc. (Jordan-Soldier Valley), and Alpine Communications, L.C. (Alpine), filed a joint application pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.20 (1999) for discontinuance of service by Alpine to the Moorhead exchange and pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29 for transfer of the certificate for that exchange to Jordan-Soldier Valley. An order approving the joint application for discontinuance of service and authorizing transfer of certificate is being issued concurrently with this amended certificate.

Jordan-Soldier Valley was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to furnish land-line local telephone service within the boundaries shown by the service territory maps on record with the Utilities Board (Board) as of January 1, 1992, pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29(12).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

This certificate of public convenience and necessity, upon issuance pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29(1) (1999), authorizes Jordan-Soldier Valley Telephone Company, Inc., to furnish land-line local telephone service in its current service territory and in the Moorhead exchange. Following Board approval of tariffs reflecting this change, Jordan-Soldier Valley is authorized to provide service in the areas as described in its tariffs at that time and also in the areas described in its tariffs as they may change in the future.
