**ORDER DOCKETING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO INTERCONNECTION
AGREEMENT FOR COMMENTS**

(Issued December 19, 2000)

On November 28, 2000, U S WEST Communications, Inc., n/k/a Qwest Corporation, and AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., filed a first amendment to their interconnection agreement adding terms, conditions, and rates for local number portability managed cuts. The Utilities Board (Board), on May 15, 1998, approved the initial interconnection agreement. Review by the Board of this amendment is pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

The parties to the negotiation or any interested party may submit written comments supporting approval or rejection of the amendment within 30 days of the filing pursuant to 199 IAC 38.7(4). Accordingly, the Board will accept written comments filed on or before December 28, 2000. The Board will determine what procedures are appropriate for review of the amended agreement after any comments are filed. Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(4), the Board must approve or

reject a negotiated interconnection agreement or amendment within 90 days of the submission, or the agreement or amendment will be deemed approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The proceeding to review Amendment No. 1 to the interconnection agreement as filed on November 28, 2000, by U S WEST Communications, Inc., n/k/a Qwest Corporation, and AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., shall be identified as Docket No. AIA-96-1.

2. Comments supporting approval or rejection of the amended agreement by the parties to the negotiation or other interested parties shall be filed on or before December 28, 2000.
