ORDER ASSIGNING TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

(Issued December 19, 2000)

On September 13, 2000, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) requested formal complaint proceedings be established against America's Tele-Network Corp. (AT-N) and its president, John W. Little. The complaint was filed pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 476.3(1) and 476.103 (1999) and 199 IAC 6.8(2) and 22.23.

An answer was filed on October 18, 2000, by AT-N and John W. Little. The Utilities Board (Board) docketed the complaint for investigation as Docket No. FCU 00-6.

The Board issued an order setting the procedural schedule for this docket on November 20, 2000. The Board will assign the matter to an administrative law judge

for proceedings to investigate the allegations of the complaint and the response of AT-N, following the procedural schedule previously set forth.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Pursuant to Iowa Code § 17A.11(1), this matter is assigned to the Board's administrative law judge for proceedings following the procedural schedule previously ordered to resolve the issues in this case.
