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**ORDER TERMINATING FILING REQUIREMENT**

(Issued March 20, 2001)

On January 22, 2001, Iowa-American Water Company (Iowa-American) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) its semi-annual hidden leak detection report. This report was required by the Board's final order issued in Docket No. RPU-90-10 because the Board was at that time concerned about Iowa-American's leak detection program.

Since Iowa-American began filing the reports, there have been two rate case settlements approved by the Board. Leak detection was not an issue in either settlement. In addition, Iowa-American has reached its initial goal with respect to the percentage of unaccounted for water. Therefore, the Board will terminate the filing requirement. Iowa-American will no longer have to file semi-annual hidden leak detection reports.

The semi-annual hidden leak detection filing mandated by Board order in  
Docket No. RPU-90-10 is terminated.
