**ORDER APPROVING WITHDRAWAL**

(Issued May 4, 2001)

On July 23, 1998, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order approving the application of Central Communications Network, L.C. (CCN), to provide local exchange service in Iowa. The order was issued in Docket No. TCU-98-11. The order stated that CCN was required to file proposed tariffs before it would be granted a certificate to provide local exchange service.

On April 20, 2001, CCN filed a request to withdraw its application. CCN stated that as of January 30, 2001, the company was officially dissolved.

The Board finds that the withdrawal of the application is reasonable. Since CCN has been officially dissolved, it will not be providing local exchange service.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The request to withdraw the application to provide local exchange service filed by Central Communications Network, L.C., on April 20, 2001, is approved.
