ORDER APPROVING WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE

(Issued November 5, 2001)

On January 26, 2001, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order approving the application of eVulkan, Inc., d/b/a beMANY! (eVulkan), for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in Iowa. The Board in the order stated that a certificate would be issued to eVulkan to commence service once it had approved tariffs showing the rates, conditions, and terms of service it would be providing.

On October 30, 2001, eVulkan filed a letter with the Board requesting immediate cancellation of its "agreement, license, certification, registration, or other recognition as an active participant in your agency's energy program." Staff contacted eVulkan on October 30 and verified the company's wishes to withdraw its approved application.

The Board notes that there is no record of eVulkan filing a tariff with the Board, nor is there record of the Board issuing a certificate to eVulkan following the January 26, 2001, order. Therefore, the Board believes it is eVulkan's intent to withdraw its current application.

The Board has considered the request to withdraw the application and finds that it is reasonable. eVulkan has not established local service in Iowa nor does it have any Iowa customers who would be affected by its withdrawal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The request of eVulkan, Inc., d/b/a beMANY!, to withdraw its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service is approved.
