ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO APPEAR

(Issued February 18, 2002)

On February 6, 2002, Mark Quandahl, an Iowa attorney, filed an appearance on behalf of Cox Iowa Telecom (Cox Iowa) in Docket No. FCU-02-1. Cox Iowa also requests the Utilities Board (Board) allow out-of-state attorney Jon Bruning to represent Cox Iowa in this proceeding, pursuant to 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e." Cox Iowa states that Mr. Bruning is licensed to practice law in both Nebraska and Iowa, but currently is on inactive status with the Iowa Bar. The request is co-signed by an attorney in good standing with the Iowa Bar, upon whom service may be made pursuant to Iowa Supreme Court rule 116.

No objection or other response has been filed. In the absence of any objection, the Board will grant the request to appear.
