ERRATA ORDER

(Issued December 17, 2002)

On November 7, 2002, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an “Order Designating Eligible Carrier” in Docket No. 199 IAC 39.2(4). The order designates Farmers Mutual Cooperative Telephone Company as a universal service eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for the purpose of receiving funding from the universal service fund, as defined by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 254. It must be clarified, however, that the competitive local exchange services and wireless services offered by Farmers Mutual Cooperative Telephone Company – Harlan are granted ETC status by the Board’s November 7, 2002, order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Ordering clause No. 1 in the Board’s “Order Designating Eligible Carrier,” issued November 7, 2002, is modified to correctly grant eligible telecommunications carrier status to Farmers Mutual Cooperative Telephone Company – Harlan’s competitive local exchange services and wireless services.

2. The Executive Secretary of the Utilities Board shall mail copies of this order to Farmers Mutual Cooperative Telephone Company – Harlan, the Universal Service Administration Company, the Federal Communications Commission Universal Service Branch, and the Federal Communications Commission Office of the Secretary.
