ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

(Issued August 28, 2003)

On August 22, 2003, Roquette America, Inc. (Roquette), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to intervene in Docket Nos. TF-03-164 and TF-03-176.

These dockets deal with proposed tariffs filed by Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) to provide non-firm best efforts standby electric service to customers with on-site generation. No objections to the petition to intervene were filed.

In support of its petition to intervene, Roquette states that it intends to construct a cogeneration facility in Keokuk. Roquette notes that the tariff proposed by IPL would have direct application to Roquette and the cogeneration facility.

The Board will grant the petition to intervene. Roquette has alleged a unique interest in this proceeding that is not currently represented.

The petition to intervene filed by Roquette America,, Inc. on August 22, 2003,
is granted.
