**ORDER RESCHEDULING ORAL PRESENTATION**

(Issued September 11, 2003)

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code §§ 17A.4, 17A.7, 476.1, 476.2, and 476.20 (2003), the Board caused a "Notice of Intended Action" to be published in IAB Vol. XXVI, No. 5 (9/3/03) pp. 333-35, as ARC 2725B. The notice proposed amendments to 199 IAC 19.4(15)"h"(5) and 20.4(15)"h"(6) to change the temperature below which a customer could not be disconnected from electric or gas service from 20 degrees Fahrenheit to 32 degrees Fahrenheit. The amendments were proposed based upon a petition for rule making filed by the Iowa Community Action Association on July 8, 2003. The Board also proposed amendments to 19.4(15)"i" and 20.4(15)"l," which contain the same 20 degree temperature standard.

In the notice, an oral presentation was scheduled for October 14, 2003, to receive comments on the proposed amendments. A scheduling conflict has developed that now prevents the Board from conducting the oral presentation on October 14, 2003. The Board is rescheduling the oral presentation to October 28,

2003. The Board has prepared an "Amended Notice of Intended Action" reflecting the new date for the oral presentation, which is incorporated herein by reference.

The Executive Secretary is directed to submit for publication in the Iowa Administrative Bulletin an "Amended Notice of Intended Action" in the form attached to and incorporated by reference in this order.

### **Amended Notice of Intended Action**

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code §§ 17A.4, 17A.7, 476.1, 476.2, and 476.20 (2003), the Utilities Board (Board) gives notice that the presentation to receive oral comments in Docket No. RMU-03-10, In re: Temperature Trigger for Cold Weather Protections [199 IAC 19.4(15) and 20.4(15)], is rescheduled from October 14, 2003, to October 28, 2003.
