**ORDER DOCKETING ANNUAL RECONCILIATION FILING
FOR FURTHER REVIEW**

(Issued October 23, 2003)

On October 1, 2003, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed its annual reconciliation of gas costs for the 12-month period ending August 31, 2003, in accordance with 199 IAC 19.10(7). On October 16, 2003, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a conditional objection to the filing. Consumer Advocate indicates that it is currently conducting a review of the reconciliation. Since the filing is voluminous and complex, Consumer Advocate conditionally objects to the filing until it has completed its review.

The Board will docket the reconciliation filing but will not set a procedural schedule at this time. Consumer Advocate shall inform the Board when it has completed its review and shall state whether Consumer Advocate believes a procedural schedule should be established.
