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**TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT**

(Issued February 20, 2004)

On January 9, 2004, Iowa Electric Light and Power Company n/k/a Interstate Power and Light Company (IP&L) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a verified petition for franchise with an application for a temporary construction permit pursuant to Iowa Code § 478.31 (2003), for .47 miles of 169,000 maximum voltage electric transmission line in Grundy County, Iowa.

In support of its request, IP&L asserted it has obtained the approval of the appropriate highway or railroad authorities, and is the nearest electric utility to the proposed point of service.

The Board has reviewed IP&L's application and finds it meets the requirements of Iowa Code § 478.31 (2003). Therefore, IP&L is granted a temporary construction permit for an electric transmission line to be operated at a maximum voltage not in

excess of that stated herein and not exceeding one mile in length over, along, and across the following described land, highways, and streams:

North Terminus is the Corn Belt Power Cooperative Wellsburg substation located in the Northeast Quarter (NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 2, T-87N, R-18W, Grundy County, Iowa.

South Terminus is an electrical connection to an existing IP&L 115kV transmission line located on the east/west centerline of Section 2, T-87N, R-18W, Grundy County, Iowa. One circuit will ultimately terminate at the Franklin substation in Section 35, T-90N, R-21W, Franklin County to the north and the second circuit at the Diesel Plant substation located within the city limits of Marshalltown in Marshall County to the south.

Beginning at the Corn Belt Power Cooperative Wellsburg substation located in the Northeast Quarter (NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 2, T-87N, R-18W of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Grundy County, Iowa, thence South .47 miles on private easement in the East Half (E  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section to an interconnection with an existing 115kV transmission line located on the east/west centerline of Section 2, all in the last named township and range.

If the Board determines that a franchise should not be granted, or that further restrictions, conditions or modifications are required, or if IP&L fails to make a sufficient and proper showing of the necessity for granting the franchise within six months of the granting of this temporary construction permit, this permit shall become null and void.

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**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The application for a temporary construction permit filed by Iowa Electric Light and Power Company n/k/a Interstate Power and Light Company, on January 9, 2004, is granted in accordance with the body of this order.
