**ORDER GRANTING ADMISSION PRO HOC VICE  
AND RECOGNIZING PARTICIPANTS**

(Issued June 18, 2004)

On June 4, 2004, Bret A. Dublinske, an Iowa attorney, filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an appearance on behalf of Cox Iowa Telcom LLC (Cox Iowa) in Docket No. INU-04-1. Cox Iowa also requests the Board allow out-of-state attorney Deonne Bruning to appear as an attorney on behalf of Cox Iowa in this proceeding. In support of its request, Cox Iowa states that Ms. Bruning is licensed to practice law in Nebraska and is a member in good standing of the Nebraska Bar.

The request appears to be in full compliance with 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e" and includes the written appearance of an Iowa-resident attorney upon whom service may be made in all matters connected with this case pursuant to Iowa Supreme Court rule 116. The motion for admission pro hac vice will be granted.

The Board notes that petitions to intervene in this docket have been received by the following: Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities; AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha; and MCI, Inc. This docket is notice-and-

comment proceeding and, as such, petitions to intervene are not required. Any party wishing to submit written comments or make an oral presentation at the comment hearing on August 24, 2004, is considered a participant in this proceeding.

Therefore, the Board will not formally grant these requests for intervention. Rather, the Board acknowledges the appearances of the aforementioned parties in this proceeding and will add them to the official service list.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The motion for admission pro hac vice filed on June 4, 2004, by Cox Iowa Telcom LLC is granted pursuant to 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e" and Deonne Bruning is authorized to appear in this proceeding as attorney on behalf of Cox Iowa Telcom LLC.

2. The Board recognizes the appearances of the Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities, MCI, Inc., AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha, in these proceedings.
