ORDER

(Issued March 23, 2005)

On March 22, 2005, Mr. Bert and Mrs. Diane Schou (the Schous) filed prepared testimony and exhibits with the Utilities Board (Board).

In paragraph one, the Schous refer to a 1978 report. In paragraph three, the Schous refer to a NIEHS 1999 report. Later in paragraph three, the Schous refer to a number of scientific articles. In paragraph 16, footnote 2, the Schous refer to a document. The items the Schous referred to are not part of the record in this case. If the Schous wish to have any of these items be a part of the record of this case, they must file a hard copy with the Board Records and Information Center and serve the other parties as required by the Board rules.

In Exhibit DS-213, the Schous refer to a website they state contains an English translation of a book, "Black on White." If the Schous wish to have any portion of the book considered to be a part of the record in this case, they must file a hard copy of the portions they wish to be part of the record with the Board Records and Information Center and serve the other parties as required by the Board rules.

The Schous must limit their filings to the relevant portions of any document or book they wish to be a part of the record. Iowa Code § 17A.14(1) (2005). The decision in this case must be based on evidence in the record. Iowa Code §§ 17A.12, 17A.14.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

If the Schous wish to have any of the items referred to in the body of this order considered to be a part of the record in this case, they must file a hard copy with the Board Records and Information Center, 350 Maple Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50319, on or before March 29, 2005, and serve the other parties as required by the Board rules.
