ORDER GRANTING WAIVER

(Issued April 8, 2005)

On April 1, 2005, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request for waiver of 199 IAC 15.17(4). This subrule requires that IPL file on or before April 1, 2005, and annually thereafter, a report of program activity related to its alternate energy purchase program for the previous calendar year. IPL requests that the April 1 filing date for the current report be extended to May 1, 2005. IPL does not request a waiver of the filing deadline for future years. The Board's staff contacted the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) and Consumer Advocate said it had no objection to the extension.

The Board will grant the waiver. IPL indicated that the additional time is required because of a change in personnel managing its alternate energy purchase program activities. The April filing date is not mandated by statute or other provision of law and does not impact public health, safety, or welfare. The standards contained in 199 IAC 1.3 for a waiver have been satisfied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The request for waiver of 199 IAC 15.17(4) filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on April 1, 2005, is granted.
