ORDER APPROVING CHANGES TO EXCHANGE BOUNDARY MAPS

(Issued April 11, 2005)

On March 31, 2005, Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom (Iowa Telecom), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to change its exchange boundary map for the Attica and Williamson, Iowa, exchanges. The filing has been identified as Docket No. TF-05-99.

Iowa Telecom's request proposes to transfer a limited area that is currently located in the Attica exchange to the Williamson exchange. Iowa Telecom states that one specific customer has recently moved into a home located within the Attica exchange and it is more economical to serve this customer from the Williamson exchange. Iowa Telecom also states that the customer agreed to be served from the Williamson exchange and that no other customers would be affected by the proposed transfer.

The Board will approve the proposed changes to the Attica and Williamson, Iowa, exchange boundaries submitted by Iowa Telecom pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29(8). The Board finds that the change is reasonable since the boundary

revision was initiated in order to use the network more efficiently, the affected customer does not object, and no other customers will be affected by the change. Iowa Telecom's request merely changes the boundaries of current exchanges covered by Iowa Telecom's certificate. Therefore, an amended certificate is not needed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The request to change the exchange boundary maps for the Attica and Williamson, Iowa, exchanges filed by Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom, on March 31, 2005, is granted. Revised maps for the Attica and Williamson, Iowa, exchanges shall be filed with the Board within 30 days of the issuance of this order.
2. The proposed changes, identified as Docket No. TF-05-99, are approved and become effective upon the issuance of this order.
