IN RE: INTERSTATE POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY	DOCKET NO. TF-05-114 (TF-05-67)
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ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED TARIFFS

(Issued May 5, 2005)

On April 8, 2005, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed a proposed tariff revision updating the level payment plan provisions of its natural gas tariff. The proposed language is intended to bring IPL's natural gas tariffs into compliance with paragraph 19.4(11)"e" of the Board rules by including a description of the computation method for calculating a customer's monthly payment. The proposed tariff has been identified as Docket No. TF-05-114. On April 27, 2005, IPL filed an amendment to the proposed tariff.

The proposed tariff language is amended as follows:

7.13A(1) Level Payment Plan Computation. The equal payment required for Customer periodically shall be determined by Company. This is derived using a 12-month usage history at the premise as well as other factors, including fuel data, basic service charges, and weather adjustment factors. Any adjustment necessary to correct an over-payment or under-payment by Customer shall be made at least once each calendar year.

The Board finds that the proposed tariff, as amended, substantially complies with the Board's level payment rules by providing the computation method used by IPL to calculate a customer's level monthly payment. The provision approved by the

Board for IPL's natural gas tariff is the same computation method included in IPL's electric tariff filed and approved in Docket No. TF-05-67.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The proposed natural gas tariff filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on April 8, 2005, as amended on April 27, 2005, identified as Docket No. TF-05-114, is approved.
