ORDER DOCKETING TARIFF

(Issued May 9, 2005)

On April 4, 2005, Global Tel*Link Corporation (Global), an alternative operator services company, filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a revised tariff to cancel and replace its previous tariff on file with the Board. The purpose of the revised tariff is to update Global's services, rates, rules, and regulations. Currently, Global does not have any operations in Iowa.

Upon initial review, Board staff found several potential errors and omissions in the revised tariff submitted by Global. Board staff contacted Global and informed its representative of the apparent errors in the revised tariff and Global agreed to submit the requested corrections and supporting documentation. Board staff has continued to contact Global regarding the revised tariff submissions but, as of the date of this order, the Board has not received the requested corrections.

Subrule 199 IAC 7.4(4) provides that if the Board does not approve a tariff filing by a rate-regulated utility, the Board shall docket the tariff for further investigation. Given the errors and omissions in Global's tariff filing, the Board will not approve the revised tariff as filed and will docket the tariff as required by Board

rule. Because Global has been notified of the errors in its revised tariff and has agreed to supplement its filing with requested corrections and documentation, the Board will suspend the tariff until such time as the corrections are filed in compliance with the Board's tariff filing requirements.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The revised tariff filed by Global Tel*Link Corporation on April 4, 2005, and identified as TF-05-104, is docketed for further investigation as described in this order.

2. Tariff filing TF-05-104 is suspended pending the filing of requested corrections to the tariff in compliance with Board's tariff filing requirements.
