ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued May 13, 2005)

On May 6, 2005, Integretel, Inc. (Integretel), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a motion for extension of time to file a response to the petition filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) on March 2, 2005. In its April 12, 2005, order docketing Consumer Advocate's petition for formal proceeding, the Board set a deadline of May 6, 2005, for Integretel's response. Integretel now asks to extend the deadline to and including May 20, 2005.

Integretel cites ongoing settlement discussions between the parties as a reason for requesting the extension. Integretel also states that counsel for Consumer Advocate has no objection to the extension. The Board finds this request reasonable and will grant the motion. However, the parties are advised that further extensions will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The motion for extension of time filed by Integretel, Inc., on May 6, 2005, is granted. Integretel must file a response to Consumer Advocate's petition for proceeding to consider civil penalty on or before May 20, 2005.
