ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND ISSUING CERTIFICATE

(Issued June 17, 2005)

On May 27, 2005, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. TCU-05-6 approving an application filed by Great Lakes Communication Corp. (Great Lakes) to provide service in the listed exchanges and approving concurrence in the Qwest exchange map. The order stated that a certificate would be issued when Great Lakes obtained an approved tariff setting forth the prices, terms, and conditions of its proposed local exchange service in Iowa.

On June 10, 2005, Great Lakes filed a proposed local exchange tariff with the Board providing the terms, conditions, and rates for local exchange service in the Lake Park, Iowa, exchange as described in the local exchange map of Qwest Corporation (Qwest). The proposed tariff has been identified as TF-05-189. Great Lakes requests the Board approve the proposed tariff and grant it a certificate to provide service in the Lake Park exchange.

As part of its request for approval of the proposed tariff, Great Lakes states that its business plan requires it to begin providing service in August 2005. Before it can begin providing service, Great Lakes states that it will need to receive telephone numbers and the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) will not

assign telephone numbers unless Great Lakes has obtained a certificate. Great Lakes requests expedited approval of its proposed tariff in order to comply with NANPA's timeframes for telephone number assignment and still be ready to begin providing service in August.

The Board has reviewed the proposed tariff and finds it substantially complies with Board rules for the filing and processing of tariff pages. The tariff contains rates for both business and residential customers. Notice was provided to all affected carriers. The Board will approve the tariff effective the date of this order, subject to complaint or investigation pursuant to 199 IAC 7.4(4), and will issue Great Lakes a certificate of public convenience and necessity concurrent with this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The tariff filed by Great Lakes Communication Corp. on June 10, 2005, is approved effective the date of this order, subject to complaint or investigation.
2. A certificate, identified as Certificate No. 0293, is being issued to Great Lakes Communication Corp. concurrently with this order.
