**ORDER GRANTING ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE
AND RECOGNIZING PARTICIPANTS**

(Issued July 20, 2005)

On July 6, 2005, David Sather, an Iowa attorney representing Qwest Corporation (Qwest) in this proceeding, filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to allow out-of-state attorneys Thomas M. Dethlefs, Timothy J. Goodwin, and Ted D. Smith to appear as attorneys on behalf of Qwest in this proceeding. In support of his request, Mr. Sather states that Mr. Dethlefs and Mr. Goodwin are licensed to practice law in Colorado and are members in good standing of the bar of those jurisdictions. Mr. Sather also states that Mr. Smith is licensed to practice law in Utah and is a member in good standing of the bar of that jurisdiction.

The requests appear to be in full compliance with 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e" and include the written appearance of an Iowa-resident attorney upon whom service may

be made in all matters connected with this case pursuant to Iowa Supreme Court rule 31.14. The motions for admission pro hac vice will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The motions for admission pro hac vice filed on July 6, 2005, by Qwest Corporation are granted pursuant to 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e" and Thomas M. Dethlefs, Timothy J. Goodwin, and Ted D. Smith are authorized to appear in this proceeding as attorneys on behalf of Qwest Corporation in these proceedings.
