ORDER REGARDING STATUS REPORTS

(Issued August 9, 2005)

On May 31, 2005, a prehearing conference was held in this docket with all parties other than Jacobsen Holz Corporation present. At the prehearing conference, the parties agreed to file status reports with the Utilities Board (Board) that keep the undersigned and the Board informed of the parties' activities in pursuing a solution. The parties agreed to file the first status report on July 29, 2005, and to file status reports every two months thereafter on the last business day of the month. This agreement was memorialized in an order issued June 1, 2005. As of the date of this order, the parties have not filed the first status report, although some parties have filed other documents regarding their activities with the Board. While the undersigned appreciates the information some parties have filed, this information does not substitute for the bimonthly status reports as agreed to by the parties.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The parties must file the first status report with the Board that informs the undersigned and the Board of the parties' activities in pursuing a solution. The status report must be filed as soon as possible.

2. Thereafter, the parties must file a status report with the Board every two months on the last business day of the month. This obligation will continue until the parties are otherwise ordered.
