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ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

(Issued August 18, 2005)

On August 9, 2005, Central Iowa Power Cooperative (CIPCO) and Corn Belt Power Cooperative (Corn Belt) filed a joint petition with the Utilities Board (Board) to intervene in Docket No. SPU-05-15. This docket involves a reorganization that would allow Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) to sell and transfer its ownership interest in the Duane Arnold Energy Center (DAEC), including nuclear fuel, to FPL Energy Duane Arnold, LLC. IPL owns 70 percent of DAEC.

In support of their petition to intervene, CIPCO and Corn Belt state that they own 20 percent and 10 percent, respectively, of DAEC. CIPCO and Corn Belt note that they are parties to various agreements with IPL concerning the ownership and operation of DAEC that may be impacted by the proposed sale. CIPCO and Corn Belt also state that the outcome of Docket No. SPU-05-15 may affect their decisions on whether to sell or retain their DAEC ownership interests.

The Board will grant the petition to intervene. CIPCO and Corn Belt have alleged a unique interest in this proceeding that is not currently represented.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The joint petition to intervene filed by Central Iowa Power Cooperative and Corn Belt Power Cooperative on August 9, 2005, is granted.
