CANCELLATION OF CERTIFICATE

(Issued October 10, 2005)

On October 11, 2001, Virginia Power Energy Marketing, Inc. (Virginia Power), filed an application for a certificate as a competitive natural gas provider (CNGP) with the Utilities Board (Board). The application was identified as Docket No. CGP-01-13. On January 15, 2002, the Board issued an order approving the application and granting Virginia Power Certificate No. G-0011.

On September 22, 2005, the Board received a letter from Virginia Power indicating that it was withdrawing its certificate. Virginia Power indicated that it had previously sent a letter to the Board stating it was withdrawing the certificate. The Board has no record of the previous letter.

Concurrently with this cancellation, the Board is issuing an order granting the request to withdraw the certificate. Certificate No. G-0011 is cancelled as requested by Virginia Power. Virginia Power indicates that it does not intend to seek other customers in Iowa.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

This certificate as a competitive natural gas provider, issued pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.87, is hereby cancelled.
