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**ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFF**

(Issued November 14, 2005)

On October 14, 2005, the Iowa Utilities Board (Board) issued an order approving a non-unanimous settlement agreement filed by Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice, and Iowa Consumers Coalition on July 20, 2005, as amended on August 5, 2005, that resolved all issues in the natural gas rate case filed by IPL in Docket No. RPU-05-1. The settlement agreement allowed IPL to increase its annual Iowa natural gas revenues by \$14,011,130 and provided that the increase would be adjusted to reflect the actual amount of IPL's rate case expense for this docket plus unrecovered rate case expense from Docket No. RPU-02-7.

In the October 14, 2005, order, the Board ordered IPL to file a compliance tariff to implement the approved rates. On October 20, 2005, IPL filed a proposed compliance tariff, identified as TF-05-288. No objections have been received.

The Board has reviewed the proposed compliance tariff and finds that the proposed rates and other changes accurately reflect the Board's order. The Board

will approve the compliance tariff as filed. The tariff will become effective  
November 18, 2005.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The compliance tariff filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on  
October 20, 2005, is approved to be effective November 18, 2005.
