**ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF CONFIDENTIAL SCHEDULE**

(Issued December 8, 2005)

On November 18, 2005, Interstate Power and Light Company filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an application for confidential treatment of Schedule H of Exhibit \_\_\_ (DV-2) (Confidential Schedule H), which was attached to IPL witness Vognsen's rebuttal testimony filed on the same date in Docket No. RPU-05-3. The Board granted the application for confidential treatment by order issued November 23, 2005.

On November 29, 2005, IPL filed a motion for withdrawal of Confidential Schedule H. IPL said the schedule contains customer-specific information. IPL stated any evidentiary value the schedule may have is outweighed by the potential prejudicial effect on IPL's customer and that protective agreements may not be sufficient to reverse that balance. There is no objection to the motion.

The Board will grant the motion to withdraw Confidential Schedule H. IPL submitted it, and IPL now wishes to withdraw it. The Board has not considered it, and it appears no other party has relied on it. Under these circumstances, it is

appropriate to grant the motion to withdraw. Any party to this proceeding with a copy of Confidential Schedule H is to destroy it or return it to IPL. The Board will destroy any copies filed with the Board.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The "Request for Withdrawal of Confidential Schedule" filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on November 29, 2005, is granted. Parties shall destroy or return to IPL any copies of Confidential Schedule H attached to the rebuttal testimony of IPL witness Vogensen.
