ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued December 13, 2005)

On December 5, 2005, American Roaming Network (ARN) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a motion for extension of time to file a response to the petition filed in this docket by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) on November 15, 2005. ARN asks that it be granted an extension of time to December 12, 2005, in which to respond.

ARN indicates that it only recently became aware of Consumer Advocate's petition and that Consumer Advocate does not object to the extension of time. The Board finds this request reasonable and will grant the motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The motion for extension of time filed by American Roaming Network is granted. American Roaming Network must file a response to Consumer Advocate's petition for proceeding to consider civil penalty on or before December 12, 2005.
