On November 23, 2005, Long Lines Metro, Inc., filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity to reflect the addition of all exchanges in Iowa being served by Qwest Corporation, Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom, and Frontier Communications of Iowa, Inc.
