**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF, APPROVING AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATE,  
CONCURRENCE IN MAPS, AND ISSUING AMENDED CERTIFICATE**

(Issued December 28, 2005)

On November 30, 2005, Advanced Network Communications, LLC (Advanced), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed amendment to its tariff that would allow Advanced to provide competitive local exchange service in all of the exchanges served by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and Frontier Communications of Iowa, Inc. (Frontier). Advanced states that it served notice of the proposed change on all affected carriers. Advanced also states that it will adopt the exchange boundary maps of Qwest and Frontier that are currently on file with the Board. The proposed tariff has been identified as TF-05-313. No objections to the proposed tariff have been filed.

The Board has considered the request and proposed tariff amendment and notes that Advanced does not indicate how it will utilize telephone-numbering resources when providing local exchange service in these new exchanges. Because telephone numbers are not an unlimited resource, if the incumbent local exchange carrier has implemented thousands-block number pooling (TBNP) in exchanges

served by Advanced, then Advanced must commit to utilize thousands-blocks of telephone numbers as opposed to ten-thousand blocks of numbers (commonly referred to as an "NXX"), even in those areas where TBNP is voluntary, whenever it is technically feasible. The Board will approve the proposed tariff amendment at this time, provided that Advanced files a statement within 30 days of the date of this order agreeing to participate in TBNP wherever technically feasible.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The proposed tariff amendment filed by Advanced Network Communications, LLC, on November 30, 2005, identified as TF-05-313, is approved.
2. The request filed on November 30, 2005, by Advanced Network Communications, LLC, to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity is approved as described in this order, subject to compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 5, below.
3. An amendment to Certificate No. 0185 is being issued concurrently with this order. Under the amended certificate, Advanced Network Communications, LLC, will be allowed to provide service in the exchanges as shown by its tariffs as currently and subsequently approved.
4. The concurrence by Advanced Network Communications, LLC, in the maps and boundaries of Qwest Corporation and Frontier Communications of Iowa, Inc., is approved.

5. Within 30 days of the date of this order, Advanced Network Communications, LLC, shall file with the Board a statement agreeing to participate in thousands-block number pooling where technically feasible.
