NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

(Issued December 30, 2005)

On April 26, 2004, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. TCU-04-3 approving an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity filed by Comtech 21, LLC (Comtech 21), on February 11, 2004.

The order stated that a certificate would be issued when Comtech 21 obtained an approved tariff setting forth the prices, terms, and conditions of its proposed local exchange service in Iowa.

On September 16, 2005, Comtech 21 filed a tariff with the Board, identified as Docket No. TF-05-271, to complete its Iowa certificate. Upon review of the proposed tariff, the Board found that the proposed tariff was deficient and, as such, it has not been approved.

On December 21, 2005, Comtech 21 filed with the Board a letter stating that Comtech 21 was agreeable to canceling its approved application because of its uncertainty of providing local exchange service in Iowa. Therefore, the Board will cancel its approval of the application for certificate filed by Comtech 21 without prejudice to refiling.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity filed by Comtech 21, LLC, on February 11, 2004, and approved by the Board on April 26, 2004, is cancelled without prejudice, effective the date of this order.
