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ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

(Issued February 7, 2006)

On January 27, 2006, Industrial Laminates/Norplex, Inc., Swift & Company, and American Profol, Inc. collectively, the (Standby Plant Customers), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a petition to intervene in Docket No. EEP-02-38. This docket involves Interstate Power and Light Company's (IPL) energy efficiency plan and various related issues, including interruptible credits. No objections to the petition to intervene have been filed.

In support of their petition to intervene, the Standby Plant Customers state they are interruptible customers of IPL and have invested large sums in standby generation facilities in accordance with IPL's interruptible rate provisions. One of the issues pending in Docket No. EEP-02-38 is the redesign of the interruptible rate.

After considering the standards set forth in 199 IAC 7.13(3), the Board will grant the petition to intervene. The Standby Plant Customers have demonstrated an interest in the subject matter of the proceeding and shown that when a decision is reached regarding the interruptible tariff, it may impact their operations. While the

proceeding has been ongoing, the Standby Plant Customers represent in their petition that they are aware of prior orders in this docket and will not attempt to delay or prolong these proceedings; the Standby Plant Customers merely desire to be heard and participate in the remainder of the proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The petition to intervene filed by Industrial Laminates/Norplex, Inc., Swift & Company, and American Profol, Inc., on January 27, 2006, is granted.
