**ORDER REGARDING THIRD STATUS REPORT**

(Issued February 7, 2006)

On February 1, 2006, Progressive Foundry, Inc. (Progressive Foundry) filed the parties' third status report and a clarification to the third status report. The status report was signed by Progressive Foundry, Jacobsen Holz Corporation, and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate). The clarification to the status report stated that counsel for Interstate Light and Power Company (IPL) had advised counsel for Progressive Foundry that IPL would not sign the status report at this time. The third status report stated that: "Copies of the Power Quality Systems' Harmonic Circuit Analysis and Mr. Conroy's review and analysis have been provided to all parties to this matter."

The purpose of the status reports is to keep the undersigned administrative law judge and the Board informed of the parties' activities in pursuing a solution. The

status report does not explain why IPL would not sign the third status report, and copies of the Power Quality Systems' Harmonic Circuit Analysis and Mr. Conroy's review and analysis were not filed with the status report. In order to more fully understand the parties' progress in pursuing a solution, the undersigned will require further explanation from IPL and a copy of the information provided to the parties.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. On or before February 17, 2006, IPL must file written clarification with the Board explaining why it would not sign the third status report at this time.
2. On or before February 17, 2006, Progressive Foundry must file a copy of the Power Quality Systems' Harmonic Circuit Analysis and Mr. Conroy's review and analysis with the Board.
