ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

(Issued February 21, 2006)

On January 27, 2006, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) proposed tariffs, identified as TF-06-19 (IPC-electric), TF-06-20 (IES-electric), and TF-06-21 (gas). The proposed tariffs revise IPL's energy efficiency cost recovery factors for the 12-month period beginning March 1, 2006. No objections to the proposed tariffs were filed.

The Board will approve the proposed tariffs. The proposed tariffs reflect projected energy efficiency expenditures for the next 12 months, as well as a reconciliation of the past year's expenditures to compensate for any over-or under-recovery. The cost recovery factors will generally increase slightly next year, although there is a small decrease in the electric energy efficiency cost recovery factors for residential and farm customers. In addition, the proposed tariffs reflect the Board's decision in an order issued December 13, 2005, in TF-05-209 and TF-05-210 (EEP-02-38). In that order, the Board approved a reduction in IPL's next energy

efficiency cost recovery tariff so that IPL, not ratepayers, would absorb the loss on its energy efficiency demonstration home in Newton.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Tariff filings TF-06-19, TF-06-20, and TF-06-21, filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on January 27, 2006, are approved, subject to complaint or investigation, effective March 1, 2006.
