NOTICE OF HEARING

(Issued March 2, 2006)

On November 10, 2005, the undersigned administrative law judge issued a procedural order and notice of hearing. At the request of the parties, the undersigned issued an order suspending the procedural schedule and canceling the hearing on December 20, 2005. On January 19, 2006, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice filed a proposed revised procedural schedule and a request by both parties that the arrangements for the hearing not be finalized until the parties verified their witnesses' availability. Telseven, L.L.C. concurred in the proposed revised procedural schedule. On January 25, 2006, the undersigned issued a revised procedural schedule and set a hearing date of April 25, 2006. The order also set a deadline of March 1, 2006, on which date the parties were required to notify the Board of their witnesses' availability so that a complete notice of hearing

could be issued. The parties have notified the Board that their witnesses are available for hearing on April 25, 2006. By prior agreement of the parties, the hearing is to be held in Ottumwa, Iowa.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The terms of the revised procedural schedule issued January 25, 2006, remain in effect. Unless specifically modified by the revised procedural schedule, the terms of the procedural order and notice of hearing issued November 10, 2005, remain in effect.

2. A hearing for the presentation of evidence and the cross-examination of witnesses will be held in the McGiverin Courtroom, 3d Floor, Wapello County Courthouse, Court and Fourth Streets, Ottumwa, Iowa 52501, on Tuesday, April 25, 2006, beginning at 11 a.m. Ms. Linda Heady will appear as a witness at the hearing. Each party must provide a copy of its prepared testimony and exhibits to the court reporter. Persons with disabilities requiring assistive services or devices to observe or participate should contact the Board at 515-281-5256 no later than ten days prior to the hearing to request that appropriate arrangements be made.
