**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF, APPROVING AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATE,
APPROVING CONCURRENCE IN MAPS, AND ISSUING
AMENDED CERTIFICATE**

(Issued March 16, 2006)

On January 25, 2006, OmniTel Communications, Inc. (OmniTel), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed amendment to its tariff that would allow OmniTel to provide competitive local exchange service in the Charles City, Iowa, exchange, including extended area service to Nashua, Iowa. OmniTel has also stated that it concurs in the exchange boundary maps in the tariffs of Qwest Corporation (Qwest) on file with the Board for the Charles City exchange. Notice of the proposed change has been served to all affected carriers and no objections to the proposed tariff have been filed. The proposed tariff has been identified as TF-06-18.

The Board has reviewed the proposed tariff and finds that it substantially complies with Board rules for the filing and processing of tariff pages. OmniTel has also filed a statement indicating that it commits to utilizing thousand-block number pooling (TBNP), even in areas where TBNP is voluntary, to the extent it is technically feasible to do so. Therefore, the Board will approve OmniTel's proposed tariff at this time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The proposed tariff filed by OmniTel Communications, Inc., on January 25, 2006, identified as TF-06-18, is approved and is deemed effective March 7, 2006, as requested by OmniTel Communications, Inc.
2. The request filed on January 25, 2006, by OmniTel Communications, Inc., to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity is approved as described in this order.
3. The concurrence by OmniTel Communications, Inc., in the maps and boundaries of Qwest Corporation is approved.
4. An amendment to Certificate No. 0207 is being issued concurrently with this order. Under the amended certificate, OmniTel Communications, Inc., will be allowed to provide service in the exchanges as shown by its tariffs as currently and subsequently approved.
