**PIPELINE PERMIT**

(Issued March 24, 2006)

Permit No. 1220 Lateral Koch Fertilizer

Permission is granted to Interstate Power and Light Company, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, to construct, operate, and maintain a pipeline in Mills County, Iowa, for the transportation of natural gas at a maximum operating pressure of 175 psig for approximately 1.34 miles over the route attached to and incorporated by reference in this permit.

Permit No. 1220 is granted subject to the provisions of Iowa Code Chapter 479 (2005), 199 Iowa Administrative Code Chapters 9 and 10, and the March 2, 2005, "Proposed Decision and Order Granting Permit" issued in this docket.

Permit No. 1220 shall be effective until March 24, 2031, unless revoked, terminated, or amended by the Utilities Board.

**Petition for Pipeline Permit  
Koch Fertilizer lateral  
4" steel pipe, 175 psig  
Marshall County, Iowa**

West Terminus is the Koch Gate Station located at the Northern Natural Gas Company pipeline located in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of Section 17, Township 84 North, Range 17 West, Marshall County, Iowa.

East Terminus is the Koch Regulator Station located on the Koch Fertilizer plant property in the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 16, Township 84 North, Range 17 West, Marshall County, Iowa.

Beginning at the Koch Gate Station located at the Northern Natural Gas Company pipeline located in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of Section 17, Township 84 North, Range 17 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Marshall County, Iowa, thence East 7,100 feet in public road right of way in the south margin of County Road E27 and near the north section line of Section 17 and 16 to the Koch Regulator Station located on the Koch Fertilizer plant property in the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 16, all in the last named township and range.
