ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND ISSUING CERTIFICATE

(Issued March 24, 2006)

On March 1, 2006, Onvoy, Inc. (Onvoy), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed local exchange tariff with the Board providing the terms, conditions, and rates for local exchange service in Iowa as described in the local exchange maps of all incumbent local exchange carriers. The proposed tariff has been identified as TF-06-69.

On February 24, 2006, the Board issued an order in Docket No. TCU-05-19 approving Onvoy's application to provide service in Iowa and approving concurrence in the maps of all incumbent local exchange carriers. The order stated that a certificate would be issued when Onvoy obtained an approved tariff setting forth the prices, terms, and conditions of its proposed local exchange service in Iowa. Onvoy requests the Board approve the proposed tariff and grant it a certificate to provide service in the listed exchanges.

The Board has reviewed the proposed tariff and finds it substantially complies with Board rules for the filing and processing of tariff pages. The tariff contains rates for both business and residential customers. Notice was provided to all affected

carriers. The Board will approve the tariff effective the date of this order, subject to complaint or investigation pursuant to 199 IAC 7.4(4), and will issue Onvoy a certificate of public convenience and necessity concurrent with this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The tariff filed by Onvoy, Inc., on March 1, 2006, is approved effective the date of this order, subject to complaint or investigation.
2. A certificate, identified as Certificate No. 0303, is being issued to Onvoy, Inc., concurrently with this order.
