ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(Issued April 12, 2006)

On March 22, 2006, the undersigned administrative law judge issued an order establishing a procedural schedule and a hearing date for this docket. Among other things, Corning Municipal Utilities (Corning) was ordered to file its prepared direct testimony on or before April 12, 2006. On April 4, 2006, the attorney for Corning orally requested a one-week extension of this date and stated the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) did not object. The undersigned directed Corning to file a written request for the extension. On April 6, 2006, Corning filed its written request. The Consumer Advocate does not object to the extension request and it should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. On or before April 19, 2006, Corning must file prepared direct testimony relating to its petition for a permit for its natural gas pipeline, as discussed in the "Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Proposing to Take Official Notice and Notice of Hearing" issued on March 22, 2006. If Corning wishes to file a prehearing brief, it must do so on or before April 19, 2006.

2. All provisions of the "Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Proposing to Take Official Notice and Notice of Hearing" issued on March 22, 2006, not specifically modified in this order remain in effect.
