ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE

(Issued April 12, 2006)

On December 23, 2002, the Utilities Board (Board) issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity, identified as Certificate No. 0260, to KMC Telecom V, Inc. (KMC), authorizing KMC to provide local telecommunications service in Iowa.

On March 28, 2006, KMC filed a request to withdraw its existing certificate. KMC states that it does not wish to maintain its certificate as it is not providing service in Iowa and does not have any customers in the state.

The Board finds that the cancellation of the certificate is reasonable since KMC is not providing service in Iowa and does not have any customers. If KMC's business plan changes and it elects to begin providing local service in Iowa in the future, KMC will need to reapply for certification.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The request of KMC Telecom V, Inc., to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity, Certificate No. 0260, filed March 28, 2006, is granted.
