On April 11, 2006, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a resistance to the motion to reconsider. On April 12, 2006, the Consumer Advocate filed a supplemental resistance to the motion to reconsider.

On April 14, 2006, the parties by their respective counsel and the undersigned met in a prehearing conference. Based on the discussion at the prehearing conference, a ruling on the motion to reconsider and the Consumer Advocate's requests made in its supplemental resistance is not necessary at this time. Rather, the parties have agreed to hold another prehearing conference after the Consumer Advocate files its rebuttal testimony and exhibits due on April 20, 2006.
