ORDER RESCHEDULING SHOW CAUSE HEARING

(Issued April 18, 2006)

On April 4, 2006, the undersigned administrative law judge issued an "Order Regarding Motion for Default and Order to Show Cause," which, among other things, set a show cause hearing in this case for April 19, 2006. On April 14, 2006, One Call Communications, Inc. (One Call) filed a request for interlocutory appeal of the order with the Utilities Board (Board). On April 17, 2006, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a resistance to the request for interlocutory appeal. The Board has not yet ruled on the request for interlocutory appeal. On April 17, 2006, One Call filed a motion for continuance of the show cause hearing. The attorney for One Call has an oral argument before the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals in St. Louis, Missouri on April 19 and 20, 2006, and cannot

reschedule the oral argument. The Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) does not object to moving the show cause hearing. The parties have agreed to reschedule the show cause hearing to April 24, 2006. The parties further agreed that One Call's witness will be connected to the hearing by telephone conference call.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The motion for continuance of the show cause hearing filed by One Call is granted. A public show cause hearing for the reasons set forth in the body of the "Order Regarding Motion for Default and Order to Show Cause" issued April 4, 2006, will be held beginning at 2 p.m. on Monday, April 24, 2006, in the Board Hearing Room, 350 Maple Street, Des Moines, Iowa.
2. All provisions of the "Order Regarding Motion for Default and Order to Show Cause" issued April 4, 2006, not specifically modified in this order remain in effect.
