ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

(Issued April 25, 2006)

On March 17, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a petition with the Utilities Board (Board) requesting the Board arbitrate interconnection agreements between Qwest and each of the following companies: Communications Specialist, Inc., d/b/a Alpha Wireless Communications Co.; Electronic Engineering Co.; E-Z Call Communications, Inc. (E-Z Call); Heartland Communications, Inc.; Lectronics, Inc.; Megacomm Corporation; and West Central Pagers, Inc. (collectively, the Respondents). The petition was filed pursuant to the provisions of Board rules

199 IAC 38.4(3) and 38.7(3) and § 252(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Pub. L. No. 101-104, 110 Stat. 56 (1996). The petition has been identified as Docket No. ARB-06-1.

On April 21, 2006, Qwest filed a motion to dismiss its petition in this proceeding against E-Z Call. In support of its motion, Qwest states that E-Z Call sold all assets involved in paging services in Iowa to Conn Communications, Inc., which has an Iowa paging agreement with Qwest, thus eliminating the need for a separate interconnection agreement between E-Z Call and Qwest.

The Board has reviewed Qwest's motion to dismiss and finds it to be reasonable. Since Qwest no longer requires an executed interconnection agreement with E-Z Call, the Board will grant Qwest's motion and dismiss E-Z Call from this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The motion to dismiss filed by Qwest Corporation on April 21, 2006, is granted.

2. E-Z Call Communications, Inc., is dismissed from this proceeding.
