ORDER CANCELING TARIFF

(Issued May 1, 2006)

Alternate Communications Technology (ACT) has an approved alternative operator services (AOS) tariff on file with the Utilities Board (Board). The tariff is identified as TF-92-131. The Board's records indicate that the last filing of record from ACT was a 2001 annual report. Since 2001, there has been no formal communication between ACT and the Board.

Board staff contacted ACT to determine its operational status. ACT informed Staff that it has not been providing any telecommunication services since 2001. Therefore, the Board will cancel ACT's AOS tariff 30 days from the date of this order unless the Board is contacted by ACT and provided with information as to why it should be permitted to maintain a tariff on file with the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Alternate Communications Technology may contact the Board with information regarding why it should be permitted to maintain a tariff on file with the Board. If the Board does not receive a response within 30 days, Alternate Communications
