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**ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS**

(Issued May 2, 2006)

On August 30, 2005, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) proposed tariff changes, identified as TF-05-259. The proposed changes, among other things, would consolidate and increase IPL's standard avoided cost rates offered to small qualifying facilities and alternate energy production (AEP) facilities that have capacities of 100 kW or less per facility.

In order to allow the Board and interested persons, particularly AEP customers, an opportunity to fully review the proposed changes, the Board on September 27, 2005, suspended the proposed tariff, set a comment period, and required IPL to file additional information. Several sets of comments were received and IPL filed the required additional information on October 17, 2005.

On March 30, 2006, the Board approved IPL's proposed tariff changes, with some modifications. IPL was directed to file compliance tariffs that reflected the Board's modifications. IPL filed its compliance tariffs on April 10, 2006. There were no objections to the compliance tariffs.

The Board will approve the compliance tariffs. The tariffs accurately reflect the modifications ordered by the Board in its March 30, 2006, decision.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

Interstate Power and Light Company's compliance tariffs filed on April 10, 2006, are approved, subject to complaint or investigation, effective as of the date of this order.
