ORDER GRANTING ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

(Issued June 15, 2006)

On June 6, 2006, the city of Titonka, Iowa (Titonka), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a motion to admit non-resident counsel, Thomas H. Frieberg, to represent Titonka in this docket. Pursuant to a verified statement filed by Mr. Frieberg with the motion, he is admitted to practice law in the state of South Dakota and agrees to submit and comply with the provisions and requirements of the Iowa Code of Professional Responsibility. Also accompanying the motion is the appearance of Amy S. Beattie, an attorney licensed to practice in the state of Iowa.

Mr. Frieberg has agreed to comply with the Iowa Code of Professional Responsibility and there is a written appearance of an Iowa-resident attorney upon whom service may be made. The motion complies with 199 IAC 7.4(8)"a" and Iowa Admission to the Bar rule 31.14(2) and will be granted.
